Benefits:

Acceptance to the accelerated programs is **not a commitment** to enter the MSE program after receiving the BSE degree, it only guarantees student acceptance to the MSE program with some benefits including the following:

1. You do not have to take the Graduate Record Examination (GRE)
2. You will end up getting two degrees (BSE and MSE or MSSE).
3. No Graduate School application fee required.
4. You can take up to 12 semester hours of common courses at the undergraduate and graduate level [must be approved by the student advisor and the Department Chair].

Students admitted to the program will be assigned a faculty advisor. The faculty advisor will outline two programs of study, one for the bachelor and another for the master's level in computer, electrical, optics and photonics, or software engineering.
